### ABOUT THE GRANTS

Portions of the annual disbursement received by the Society for Classical Studies and the American Classical League from the Rudolph Masciantonio legacy gift fund will be used to advance the creation of a more inclusive environment in the field of Ancient Mediterranean Studies in K-12 education and offer assistance to teachers of K-12 students and those who are pursuing a career in K-12 education in areas relevant to our discipline (Latin, Ancient Greek, and Classics).

**The Rudolph Masciantonio Latin Teacher Grants to Support DEI Initiatives:** \$1,200 grant to provide funding for classroom supplies, projects, and activities that support programs in under-resourced schools or that teach primarily students underrepresented in the fields associated with Classical Studies.

**The Rudolph Masciantonio Support Grant for Student Teachers of Latin:** \$5,000 grant to provide financial support to an individual during their semester of student-teaching in a Latin program.
