Since the Subscription Only option for candidates was eliminated beginning with the 2003-04 Placement Year, the ratios in this historical table have been re-calculated so they will be compatible with future tables (see the [2000-2001 table](#) for ratios calculated using all candidates registered with the Placement Service).

In the 2001-2002 Placement Year, there were a total of 204 positions advertised with the Placement Service (184 definite and 20 possible). The status of these searches follows: 161 filled, 11 ongoing, 23 cancelled or not filled, 6 filled but not with a classicist, 3 outcome not reported to the APA.
